Eight "Most Wanted" numbers from the wanted lists issued with Page 132 were factored on Page 133. NFS@Home factored 3,619+, 5,424+, 6,389+, 12,277-, 12,274+, 3,619-, 10,302+ and 10,304+, all by the Special Number Field Sieve.

Two "More Wanted" numbers from the wanted lists issued with Page 132 were factored on Page 133. NFS@Home factored 3,631+ and 3,632+, both by the SNFS.

Four "Smaller-but-Needed" numbers from the wanted lists issued with Page 132 were factored on Page 133, all by the General Number Field Sieve. NFS@Home factored 6,460+, 7,373-, 11,671M and 10,325+.

New wanted lists are enclosed.

NFS@Home is a group led by Greg Childers. yoyo@home is a distributed group in Germany.

There was one new champion for factoring Cunningham numbers on this page. Recall that a champion is one of the best two records in its class. The number 10,302+ C289 in # 6409 was the champion (second place) for largest penulimate factor. A list of recent champions is enclosed.

On Page 133 the last Cunningham number $b^n \pm 1$ with $b^n \le 10^{300}$ was factored. It was 3,619 – c207 in # 6408.

The first holes factored on Page 133 are in # 6400, # 6403, # 6404, # 6405, # 6407, # 6408, # 6409, # 6411, # 6412, # 6413, and # 6415. No second, third or fifth hole was factored on Page 133. The only fourth hole factored on Page 133 is in # 6395.

The smallest new factor reported on Page 133 has 61 digits. See # 6397. The largest number factored on Page 133 has 289 digits. See # 6409.
